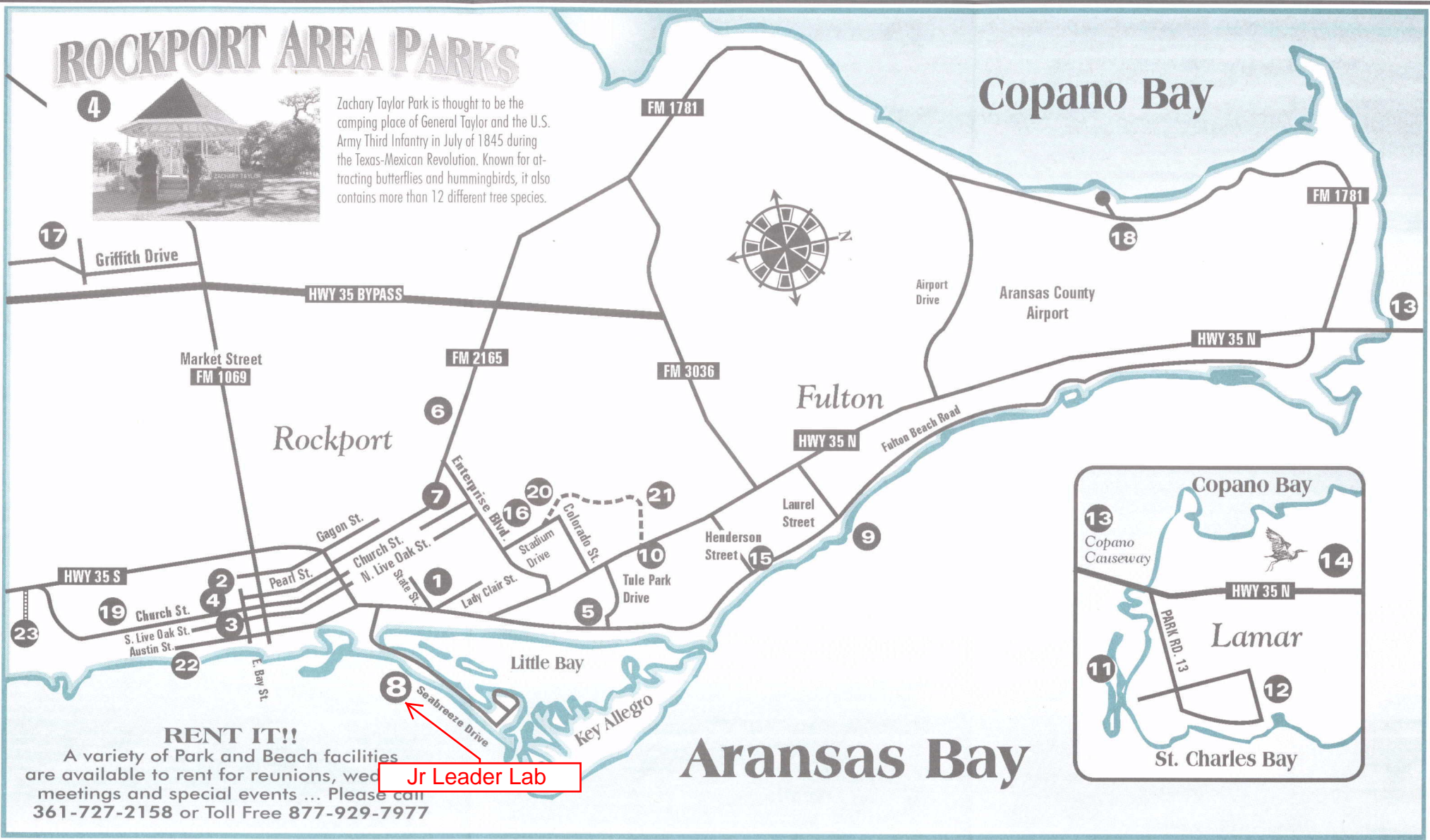


ROCKPORT AREA PARKS



Zachary Taylor Park is thought to be the camping place of General Taylor and the U.S. Army Third Infantry in July of 1845 during the Texas-Mexican Revolution. Known for attracting butterflies and hummingbirds, it also contains more than 12 different tree species.

1. **Triangle Park** 811 Hwy. 35 N. Gazebo, wildflowers in season, benches, scenic view. (City Park)
2. **Spencer Park** 400 East Bay. Basketball court & playground with picnic shelter and play area. (City Park)
3. **Mathis Park** 801 South Live Oak Street. Full size basketball court, picnic area, and playground. (City Park)
4. **Zachary Taylor Arboretum Park** 702 S. Pearl St. Historic Live Oak landscaped Historical Site with gazebo, picnic area and "specimen tree" signs.
5. **Tule Park** 2105 Picton Lane Practice fields, Gazebo, green space with pond.
6. **Memorial Park** 1601 North Pearl St. (at FM 2165) 52 acre park with tennis and basketball courts, playground, picnic sites, shelters, soccer and baseball fields & rest rooms. Walk/bike nature trail (1.6 miles), fitness stations and 2.5 acre pond with birding sites. (City Park)
7. **Tiger Field** 1301 North Live Oak. Softball fields, picnic sites, basketball court, walking/jogging trail, rest rooms & playground. (County Park)
8. **Rockport Beach Park** Seabreeze Drive. Pavilion rentals, play areas for kids, 3/4 mi. walking trail, rest rooms and showers, fishing & crabbing pier, public boat ramps, saltwater swimming lagoon, protected birding areas with viewing area, ADA picnic cabanas & thatched umbrellas ... And Texas' only Blue Wave Beach! (City Park)
9. **Fulton Beach Park** 102 DeForest Loop. Picnic shelters, playground, fishing pier, rest rooms. Next to Fulton Harbor. (Town of Fulton Park)
10. **Wetland Pond/Demo Gardens** Hwy. 35 North Nature trail (.8 mile) with interpretive sites, boardwalk and picnic sites. (TXDOT, City, Aransas First)
11. **Goose Island State Park** Park Rd. 13, Lamar Picnic sites, rest rooms, fishing pier, boat ramp and overnight camping. (State of Texas Park)
12. **Big Tree** 12th Street just off Park Rd. 13 in Lamar State historical site with one of the oldest oaks in Texas, benches and view of the bay. (State of Texas Park)
13. **Copano Bay Fishing Pier** Hwy. 35 N. at Lyndon B. Johnson Causeway. Public fishing, concessions, long piers and boat launch. (Aransas County Navigation District Facility)
