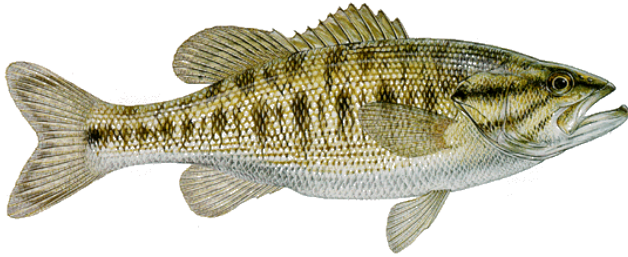


4-H Sportfishing Project Leader Training

Cost is \$25 per registrant.

Training: The training will include classroom education and hands on exercises including fishing and water activities. Training topics will include basic fishing skills, aquatic ecology, fish biology and habitat, gear and tackle, curriculum and resources, and more. All registrants 18 years of age and older will also be eligible to become certified Texas Parks and Wildlife Angler Education Instructors.

Lodging: Lodging is on your own. Cabins, RV sites, and camping sites are available at the park by reservation. Contact the park through the website above. Additional camping may be available at the Lake Bastrop North Shore Park, Bastrop State Park, Buescher State Park, and other facilities in the area. Hotels are abundant in the area within 5 miles.
