REMINDER:

**Qualifying Classes:** A 4-H member must simply show (not earn points) in at least one class within a division in order to qualify for all the classes in that division at the State 4-H Horse Show.

**Open/Invitational Classes:** Any 4-H member with a properly validated horse project may enter any or all open classes at the State 4-H Horse Show. **Competing at District is not required to enter these classes.**
