- ONE paper handout or other items distributed to voting delegates during Lab.
- One campaign poster may be displayed during Lab. Posters should be removed when elections are completed.
- All candidates are required to give a speech at Lab, which will be evaluated. A time limit of three (3) minutes will be enforced.
- Candidates will also be interviewed. Questions for the interview will be taken from information
  presented on the Officer Candidate Registration form (leadership, project experiences, community
  service) and knowledge of the 4-H Program. Candidates should be familiar with the following sections of
  the online 4-H Management Guide System, Membership Units and History of 4-H in Texas.
- At no time during Leadership Lab is anyone allowed to use candles or fire for props.
