#### General Rules

- Each participant must fill out a waiver and turn it in on the day of the contest.
- Any 4-H or FFA member is eligible.
- Coaches may enter as many individuals or teams as desired. (team will consist of 3 to 4 members) Top three total scores will make up team score.
- Contest will be divided up into Junior and Senior divisions.
  - Junior (3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
  - Senior (9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade) Juniors are eligible to judge as seniors.
- Contest will consist of a minimum of 8 classes.
  - Juniors will answer questions.
  - Seniors will give 3 to 4 sets of oral reasons.
- The results announced will be final.
- Awards will be given for junior and senior divisions as individuals and teams.
