Requirements for Camp Saddle Sore 2019:

- 1. Attach current NEGATIVE copy of Coggins to registration form.
- 2. Drivers **MUST** have original *current* negative Coggins for all horses hauled into county owned facility.
- 3. All fees are due with registration form, including electrical hook-up fees. We have VERY limited space for RV hook-ups, first paid, first served. (We will refund if sold out).
- 4. Authorization and Release form must be filled out completely and attached to registration form.
- 5. No shavings in stalls. ALL HAY SHOULD BE REMOVED at the end of camp from all stalls. DO NOT DUMP WATER BUCKETS IN THE STALLS!!
- 6. Remember at Camp Saddle Sore, your horse is taken care of first. You will be fed after he/she has eaten (in plain words if you want to eat feed your horse first).
- 7. Stall committee will be patrolling. If water is added, or if stall needs to be cleaner, you will find a note on your stall.
- 8. Check in has been changed. Look for signs indicating which gate to enter through.
- 9. If you a bringing a different horse than you registered with, have your Coggins ready, you will need it.
- 10. Kickers need tail ribbons to warn other riders. We have extras..ask us.
- 11. If you need anything, have any problems, or need any help, look for a STAFF member. We want to help you.
- 12. <u>Sleeping arrangements</u> will be in Fairground buildings on the floor. Bring your mattress, bedroll, sleeping bag or whatever makes you comfortable.

Rules That WILL Be Enforced At Camp Saddle Sores 2019

Your Agreement to The Registration and Release confirms your Agreement to all the Rules and Regulations.

- 1. We have of riders waiting to attend Camp Saddle Sores; we do not have the facilities or staff to accommodate everyone who wants to be here. This event was intended to educate and indoctrinate kids about the Drill Experience, and to have a LOAD of fun. We *love sponsoring* this camp, BUT, if you are not serious about horsemanship, if you are not willing to help, or if you are a whiner, we ask you to stay home. Do not attend if you cannot be flexible, do not attend if you need one on one instruction, if you are not willing to sweat or freeze, or if you are not willing to be uncomfortable occasionally. We can't control the weather, we can deal with it!
- 2. Coggins will be checked at arrival...do not come without <u>current</u> **negative** Coggins papers, **Or you will be turned away at the gate.**
- 3. Any Camper not sleeping in the dorms will have to be signed out with the Camp Coordinator by a parent or guardian <u>BEFORE 8:30 p. m.</u>, or we may exercise our right to send the camper home without further riding. No Exceptions, No Refunds, No T-Shirt.
- 4. Campers sleeping off premises must sign back in with the Camp Coordinator on both Saturday and Sunday mornings *no later than* 6 am. Or they *will be removed from* <u>Camp with no refund or excuses.</u>
- 5. Be ready to ride when it's time to be ready, nobody wants to wait on a slow-poke. If you need help saddling or mounting let us know as soon as you get here, we have people who want to help you.
- 6. *Don't even think about riding bare-back* if you are not in the bare-back class, it's not safe, we do not do that here, go do it in your pasture, not ours. We cannot be responsible for you, so we cannot allow it.
- 7. When riding, you must wear boots with heels, no flip-flops, no tennis shoes, and no bare feet period, no comment, no whine allowed, don't do it or you won't ride. (Chukkas are OK).
- 8. Do not tend to horses without closed toed shoes on your feet. No sandals, no flip-flops, no bare feet.
- 9. Don't even think about riding in anything other than jeans, no shorts on horseback, no matter how cute you are.
- 10. No double riding, no sharing, or trading horses, Period.
- 11. Those big pipe gates are your riding limit! Walk your horse from there, no riding around trailers, and don't run over people walking (especially the old, the tired, and the very young).
- 12. No Iguanas, dogs, cats, goats, pigs, cattle, sheep, fowl, or any sort of animal; (other than children), may be allowed on premise without a secure leash *attached all the time*, and by all means, **no** animals of any kind are allowed in the food-service areas or eating areas at *any*-time! As always does not apply to Certified Service Animals.
- 13. Our language will reflect our presence at a public function. No back-talk, no sass, no cursing, or the Camp Director may just chunk you and your horse out of camp at their discretion.
- 14. Our precious children don't do alcohol or tobacco, and they surely won't do it here. So you older riders will set the example. No alcohol is allowed on camp grounds.
- 15. We insist on the use of headstalls, no one is allowed to ride *at all* with a halter; you need a bit or a hackamore to be safe. (Classes excluded)
- 16. We will have Medical Personnel, (and lots of experienced Moms and Dads) on premise or available at all times, find anyone of our STAFF for any assistance, or you can just fall down and yell a lot, we'll find you eventually.
- 17. All horses must be stalled by 8:30 p.m. each night; late arrivals on Friday will be allowed to exercise horses within reason. We ask that an adult be around riders at all times.
- 18. No one is allowed to operate any motorized vehicle without an appropriate license.
- 19. DO NOT tie off horses to back wash rack water piping! Do not tie to temporary stalls.
- 20. We intend to have a lot of fun, learn new skills, meet new friends, work hard and long, get a little sleep and eat well. We simply ask that you be on good behavior so that everyone can enjoy their Camp Saddle Sore experiences. We try to keep a family atmosphere. HAVE A GOOD EXPERIENCE AND LEARN SOMETHING NEW OR AT LEAST TRY.
