Workshop: WHEP and the WHEP Manual will be briefly explained. The WHEP contest will be set up to allow participants to apply the information in the habitat. Participants will be able to work in groups of any size and complete activities using their Manual in the field. An abbreviated format will be used to accommodate the time frame. Following each contest activity, official answers will be given, explained, and discussed. Habitat evaluation and management will be discussed. Adults and youth will participate together to learn more about the project.
