

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WHO WE ARE

The ambassador team is a very unique youth-adult partnership that utilizes great synergy to create educational programs for the both the team members and other youth and adults in the 4-H program.

OUR HISTORY

The STEM Ambassadors were originally founded by Dr. Toby Lepley and Kevin Wentzel as the Texas 4-H Technology Team in November of 2004. We started out with just nine members, four volunteers, and one 4-H Specialist. Now, the team has grown to include 15-20 youth members, several collegiate members, and a group of adult advisors.



Since its beginning, the "Tech Team" has played an essential role in promoting the integration of technology into local and state 4-H programs. By 2019, The Tech Team had expanded to encompass all areas of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics, and was thus renamed as the Texas 4-H STEM Ambassadors.
