District 11 4-H Share the Fun Video Upload Guidelines

- 1. The uploaded video should be a recording of the youth or group presenting their performance. The video must be of the contestant(s) only.
- 2. Video upload requirements:
 - a. Video must be uploaded using Youtube platform. Acceptable video file formats will include: Quicktime movie (.mov), Windows Media (.avi) or as a MPEG (.mp4) in standard HD or Ultra HD 4K quality.
 - b. Video will be titled in the following format:
 - i. "County, Contestant Name (or last names of all members if part of a group), Category".
 - ii. Example: Susie Smith from Aransas County is participating in the Vocal category will have her video named "Aransas, Susie Smith, Vocal".
 - c. Videos must be uploaded in an UNLISTED privacy setting.
 - d. Film at the highest resolution possible and ensure audio quality.
 - e. Do not add additional graphics, transitions or other effects. The video must be recorded in one continuous video. <u>Edited videos will be disqualified.</u>
- 3. Contestants will copy/paste their link and email to their County Extension Agents.
- 4. Agents will upload the direct links (after verifying they are correct and work) to the google form link provided to the county extension agent. Only one upload per contestant/team is permitted. Additional submissions will not be accepted. All links must be submitted by APRIL 2, 2021 for judging. Failure to upload will result in no participation or scoring.
 - a. If a group is submitting, enter the last name of all participants.

Tips/Recommendations for videos:

• Record in a landscape/horizontal format.

• The video may be recorded from waist up or head to toe, but all features of the performance need to be captured.

• The video should be recorded using a neutral background with contestant only.

• Check audio quality and video resolution before submitting. If audio/video is of poor quality, judges reserve the ability to award zero points for any and all categories in the rubric.
