RULES, GUIDELINES, AND HELPFUL HINTS FOR SHEPHERDS TO COMMUNICATE TO THEIR CAMPERS

<u>BE AN EXAMPLE</u>	SMILE, ENCOURAGE, PARTICIPATE, BE SUBMISSIVE TO LEADERSHIP, AND HAVE A <u>POSITIVE ATTITUDE!</u>
<u>SHEPHERDS</u>	<u>YOU</u> ARE ACCOUNTABLE FOR THE KIDS WHEREABOUTS AT <u>ALL</u> TIMES. EVERYONE CPT TRAINED?
<u>ACCOUNTABILITY</u>	GENDER-SPECIFIC LODGING AT ALL TIMES. NO PDA. AVOID BEING HIDDEN ONE-ON-ONE WITH KIDS.
<u>SECURITY</u>	ALWAYS WEAR CAMPER ID, I.E. LANYARDS, BRACELETS, ETC... DO NOT TAKE KIDS OFF-CAMPUS.
<u>VISITORS</u>	NOTIFY THE CAMP OFFICE, AHEAD OF TIME, OF ANY EXPECTED VISITORS. OTHERWISE, DON'T INVITE 'EM.
<u>VEHICLES</u>	PARK WHERE INSTRUCTED, LOCK IT, & LEAVE IT. NO DRIVING IN CAMP. GOLF CARTS CAN BE DANGEROUS.
<u>MEDICATIONS</u>	THE CAMP NURSE IS THE ONLY PERSON ALLOWED TO STORE OR ADMINISTER CAMPER OR ADULT MEDS, PRESCRIPTION & NON-PRESCRIPTION, EXCEPT IMMEDIATE-USE MEDS FOR LIFE-THREATENING CONDITIONS. OTHER EXCEPTIONS TO MEDICATIONS MUST BE CLEARED BY THE CAMP DIRECTOR, CAMP NURSE, & STATE CODE.
<u>HYDRATION</u>	DRINK LOTS OF WATER DURING REC – BOTH KIDS AND ADULTS.
<u>FACILITIES</u>	NO INDOOR REC. DON'T USE DUCT TAPE, TICKY-TACK, OR PAINT. NO DRINKS IN THE CONFERENCE AREAS.
<u>CLEANING</u>	SET TRASH BY THE ROAD EACH MORNING. USE CLEANING SUPPLIES PROVIDED. KEEP CABINET LOCKED.
<u>DAMAGES</u>	YOU BREAK IT, YOU PAY IT. REPORT ANY DAMAGE IMMEDIATELY, PREFERABLY DURING THE DAYTIME.
<u>AIR CONDITIONING</u>	LEAVE 'EM SET AT 70° & TRUST 'EM TO WORK. SETTING IT LOWER <u>ASSURES</u> THAT IT WILL STOP WORKING.
<u>DRESS CODE</u>	ADDRESS CLOTHING ISSUES IMMEDIATELY. COVER-UPS TO WATER VENUES & FULL SHOES AT WATERFRONT.
<u>WATERFRONT</u>	STAY OUTTA THE BAY – LOTS OF HIDDEN DANGERS. OYSTER SHELLS, SHARP ROCKS, DROWNING. OBEY LGs!
<u>TABOO</u>	PLEASE REFRAIN FROM GUM, SHAVING CREAM, WATER BALLOONS, ETC... FOR DORM REC PURPOSES.
<u>THANKS!</u>	WE CONSIDER YOU AS STAFF. YOU MAKE CAMP AFFORDABLE FOR KIDS. YOU'RE A BLESSING TO THIS MINISTRY!
